- Setting standards that comply with the relevant statutory requirements relating to health, safety and welfare concerning employees, subcontractors, visitors and the general public.
- Ensuring hazardous substances used in the workplace are identified, handled, stored, transported and used in a safe manner.
- Ensuring employees using plant and machinery have adequate guidance, instruction, and training, and the plant machinery is operated safely and stored in a safe manner.
- Providing adequate resources to comply with our statutory requirements regarding the health, safety and welfare of all those affected by Reside Construction Ltd activities.
- Setting, measuring and monitoring OH & S Objectives in order to continuously improve its performance of the OH & S management system.

The policy statement will be reviewed annually as part of the Quality Management System review, to ensure Reside Construction Ltd is working to all current legislation and best practice.
